ALUMNUS MAKES \$2 MILLION GIFT TO SEDGWICK COUNTY ZOO

Spotlight on Don Slawson '55

Don Slawson '55, his wife, Judy, and their children recently completed the Slawson Family Tiger Trek at the Sedgwick County Zoo. Don approached the zoo's executive director in 2006 about bringing a tiger exhibit back to the zoo after an absence of more than 10 years. Following a feasibility study and cost analysis he and his family—including **Todd '84** and **Craig '80**—made an initial gift of \$1 million with a challenge for the zoo to raise another \$1 million from the private sector. Once matched, Don stepped up with a second million dollar gift to complete the exhibit.

From the initial donation to the grand opening of the Slawson Family Tiger Trek on May 22, 2009, Don has been an ardent supporter of the 50,000 square foot exhibit, which houses Asian tigers weighing up to 500 pounds. The exhibit designed by WDM Architects, has room for up to six adult tigers with a river, two pools, and a natural habitat to showcase the big cats. Don said, "Our family views this new exhibit as a way to protect and preserve the

species while giving back to the community that has meant so much to us."

Speaking of giving back, the Slawson family has also been very generous to Delta Upsilon. A loyal, giving, and longtime benefactor of the Kansas Chapter and DU International, Don and his family made a substantial contribution during the last major capital campaign for the rebuilding and furnishing of the Chapter House dining room, which is named in their honor. Don also created a significant endowed fund with DU International to allow undergraduate

brothers to attend the summer leadership institute annually at no charge to the Chapter.

In addition to philanthropic gifts, the Slawsons volunteer in many civic and charitable endeavors in the Wichita community. Don served as a member and past chairman of the State Board of Regents, as a longtime trustee of Wichita Collegiate School, and was instrumental in helping establish the Garvey Institute of Law at Friends University.

Don has been successful in building oil and gas companies, real estate, hotel, and restaurant development. Real estate projects include NewMarket Square, Oak Creek, Cross Pointe, and Tallgrass. Residential projects include Briarwood Lakes Estates, Brookhaven Estates, Mill Pond, Socora Village and Woodbridge. Slawson Companies, headquartered in central Wichita, has offices in Denver, Oklahoma City and Houston. Don is a past recipient of our Chapter's highest honor, the Kansas DU Distinguished Alumni Award.
