INTRAMURALS

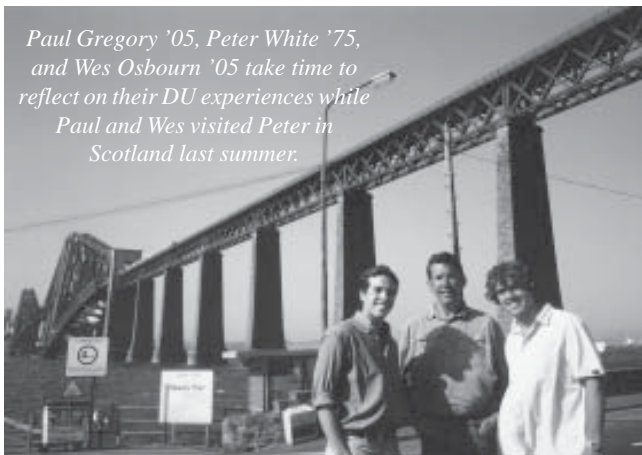
